

Mt. Zion Baptist Church Leadership Commitment Form - 2008

The purpose of this leadership commitment form is to give each leader at Mt. Zion an opportunity to do the following:

- Assess God's call on their life to serve at Mt. Zion
- To prayerfully consider if you can fulfill God's call on your life to serve under the leadership of Pastor Kennedy and established leadership
- To understand what is expected of you as a leader at Mt. Zion
- To make a personal commitment in writing to the Lord, the leadership of Mt. Zion, and the congregation of Mt. Zion to serve faithfully
- To demonstrate one of the greatest qualities of leadership: namely one's ability to follow leadership.

I understand that the Senior Pastor and the leadership of Mt. Zion have expectations for every leader. Therefore, I agree to be faithful in fulfilling the following expectations as a leader at Mt. Zion Baptist Church:

1. To maintain my love relationship with God, my spouse, children, family members, the people I serve at Mt. Zion, and others as God gives me opportunity (Mark 12:29-31; Gal. 6:10).
2. To cheerfully contribute to the storehouse at Mt. Zion by giving a minimum of 10% of my gross income according to Prov. 3:9-10; Gen. 14:18-20; 28:20-22; Lev. 27:30; Mal.3:10; and Matt. 23:23 (FYI if you want to grow to the next level in giving consider Luke 6:38; and II Cor. 9:6-8).
3. To attend a Systematic Bible Study at Mt. Zion on a regular basis (Sunday School, Wednesday Night Bible Study, or Thursday noonday Bible Study).
4. To attend Prayer Meeting at least once a month. (Col. 4:2; Acts 1:12-14).

5. To attend Worship Service on a consistent basis (Heb.10:24-25).

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6. To work cooperatively with my respective Department Head or other assigned leader.
7. To attend monthly leadership meetings (usually scheduled on the first Wednesday of the month at 6:00 pm or other established time). Work schedules, illness, or serious family issues are understandable. However, please be honest with God and with your co-laborers in Christ.
8. Commitment to submit reports to Department Head as requested.
9. When my vision for ministry conflicts with and creates conflicts with the established vision of the Senior Pastor, the leadership, and congregation of Mt. Zion I will gracefully submit to the established vision or I will gracefully resign my position.
10. To submit to the Pastoral Leadership of the Senior Pastor (Heb. 13:17; I Pet. 5:1-4).
11. To disclose to the Senior Pastor in confidence any legal, personal, or spiritual reason(s) that you may not lead or have direct contact with children or the people that you are ministering to.
