"No Other Gospel"

Galatians 1:1-10 *Dr. Jeff lorg*

TEXT QUESTIONS TO PASTOR AS HE IS PREACHING TO: (909) 906-0272

Introduction

Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life." That's it. Why do we want everything in life to be precise, except spiritual issues? The foundation of our faith is a sure gospel – resting on the resurrection of Jesus. Yet, despite the historical fact of that sure foundation, error about the gospel abounds.

I. The gospel is clearly communicated.

What the Bible says

- 1. v5 Jesus "gave himself for our sins."
- 2. v5 Jesus gave himself "to rescue us from this evil age."
- 3. v5 Jesus gave himself "according to the will of our God and Father."
- 4. v5 Jesus giving himself results in "glory forever and ever" to God.

What the Bible means for you

Jesus is the only way of salvation and God's plan of salvation deserves a big amen!

II. The gospel is easily perverted.

What the Bible Says

- 1. v6 Heresy erupted quickly in the church.
- 2. Heresy emerged from three sources:
 - a. v7 "Some" who changed the gospel. anonymous experts
 - b. v8 "we" prominent leaders
 - c. v8 "an angel" angelic or supernatural revelation

What the Bible Means for You

Don't be surprised when heresy erupts in the church – promoted by anonymous experts, religious leaders, or angelic messengers.

III. The gospel is often divisive.

What the Bible Says

- 1. v8-9 Changing the gospel invites God's judgment.
- 2. v10 Upholding the gospel creates relational tension.

What the Bible Means for You

Holding to the gospel is hard in personal relationships.
