Not My Will, But Your Will Be Done

Matt. 26:36-46 NASB95

TEXT QUESTIONS TO PASTOR AS HE IS PREACHING TO: (909) 906-0272

Note: When you pray, not my will, but Your will be done, you are distinguishing yourself from the world of creative individualism. You are also distinguishing yourself from cultural Christianity. Cultural Christianity allows you to justify clear violations of God's design for the family. For instance, feeling superior, or as an exception to others, stepping out on your spouse, lying to get ahead. Another example is schemes driving property values down by allowing rising crime, business failures, trashed neighborhoods, forcing people to sell far below property values, then buying the property cheap, taking over the community, and then pricing people out of the community to make a gentrified community. God condemned scheming and stealing people's land, their homes, and inheritance, in Micah 2:1-5. Another example is, being quick to harm, or not even think about how we are harming others in violation of the "Golden Rule." The "Golden Rule" says treat other people the way you want to be treated (Matt. 7:12). Praying, not my will, but Your will be done is the DNA of Biblical Christianity. It might be a struggle to pray this prayer, but real Christians pray this prayer because we want to honor God by doing what is right according to God's Word, and we want to be a blessing to our families and others in the world around us. You can be confident in praying this selfless prayer because Jesus, our Savior and Lord, prayed, not My will, but Your will be done.

Take it Home Point: Pray, not my will, but Your will be done.

- A. This Prayer is an "All-Inclusive" Prayer (Matt. Chapters 21-26).
- B. This Prayer Requires Times of Solitude (Matt. 26:36).
- C. This Prayer Requires Focus Even Among Your Inner Circle (Matt. 26:36-38, 40).

Note: Praying, not my will, but Your will be done drives your obedience to God, it helps you live out God's plan to use you to help your family and others, and it positions you to receive your reward from God (Matt. Chapters 26-28; cf. Phil. 2:5-11; Psalm 1).

Personal Challenge: In a world determined to do life without God, or partially with God, dare to do life completely with God and for God by praying, "Father, not my will, but Your will be done."

Personal Prayer: Lord with so many ways to compromise obeying You and doing the right thing, help me consistently pray, not my will, but Your will be done. Lord, help me to pray this prayer for all areas of my life. Lord, give me times of solitude so you have my undivided attention and can speak to my heart. Lord, help me to focus even when I am on a different page with my trusted friends. Lord, help me follow the example of Jesus, my Savior and Lord, in praying, not my will, but Your will be done. I live to love and serve You, in the name of Jesus I pray, amen.
