Teacher Requirements

Qualifications

Must be at least 18 years old.

Must provide school transcripts.

Must have pre-employment physical and current negative TB test.

Must be fingerprinted through the Department of Justice.

Must have current First Aid and CPR and Health and Safety course

A.A. degree in early childhood education, child development or related field or

At least 12 units in early childhood education, child development or related field

At least two years of related experience

Responsibilities

- Work well with director, administrator and other staff members
- Follow all school policies and procedures
- Attend staff meetings
- Keep director informed in advance of program needs
- Conduct parent conferences
- Prepare and post developmentally appropriate lesson plans
- Greet parents and maintain a professional relationship with them
- Be opened to attend seminars
- Supervise and interact with children
- Treat all children with respect and dignity
- Report to director any special needs or problems of individual children
- Sit with children during meals
- If aide is assigned, give duties before class if possible
- Initiate active learning by providing a wide variety of experiences for the children
- Make sure the school environment is safe and clean indoors and outdoors
- Decorate the classroom and bulletin boards with children's art work and pictures
- Report to director any suspected child abuse or neglect
- Other duties may be assigned
